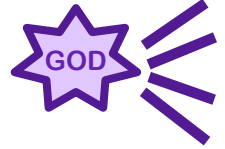
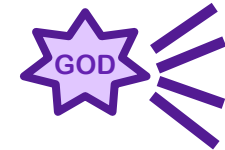
God's Truth/Word is Presented
