Devotional Idea: God alone is worthy of worship and praise, and when we consider all He has done for us, our praise and thanksgiving as well as our reverent submission are appropriate responses for forgiven sinners to offer as expressions of adoration!

**Bless the Lord ... *He is the One True and Living God!*
Consider Who He Is!**

**Bless the Lord ... *And forget not all His Benefits!*
Consider What Has He Done?**

- "Who forgives ALL your iniquity"
- "Who heals all your diseases,"
- "Who redeems your life from the pit,"
- "Who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,
- "Who satisfies you with good – so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."

**Bless the Lord ... *As You Reflect on His Nature!*
Consider What is He Like?**

- "The Lord is merciful and gracious."
- The Lord is "slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love."
 - "He will not always chide,
 - "Nor will he keep his anger forever."
 - "He does not deal with us according to our sins,"
 - "Nor repay us according to our iniquities"

**Bless the Lord ... *As You Respond to Him Appropriately!*
Consider How You Should Respond to Him?**

- ... Toward those who fear Him
- ... To those who keep his covenant & remember to do his commandments.
